She has volunteered to take up the Village Adoption programme with all earnestness to bring about a change in Learning outcomes of village kids in 200 days.

PROGRAMME :

To implement Pratham Mysore's successful models in Preschool Education, Reading and Maths in order to create an impact and bring about a positive change in learning levels of children in HUNDI MALA.

METHODOLOGY :

Under the initiative the volunteer trained by Pratham Mysore will work for 2 hrs daily with village Anganwadi (Preschool Centre) teacher in imparting Preschool education using Pratham Balawadi kits containing locally developed, cost effective and safe materials to kindle the child's interest in learning.

The volunteer will also carry out activities in village Government school to assist the Govt. School teachers in handling Pratham's Reading (Kannada Vachana Krayakrama) and Maths (Nagu Nagutha Ganitha) programmes.

The Reading Programme (Kannada Vachana Krayakrama) which is used for building language in children of grade 1 to 7 is a remedial package intended to correct the graded difficulties at different levels of reading and pronunciation and is supported by pre and post evaluation. The effort is captured using attractive tools designed to carry the children from different

grade towards the desired reading competencies consisting of colorful story cards, alphabet grid which helps the child to use it as a reference card and a number of materials to carry out activities which support in learning.

The maths programme (Nagu Nagutha Ganitha) which is again a remedial package marks a significant shift from the conventional teaching methods towards a child led model of learning which focuses on fostering thinking strategies among children so that they explore different ways of arriving at mathematical solutions.
